Participants must bring their own tools (i.e., shovels or trowels) to minimize contact through sharing, as well as their own provisions (gloves, hats, sunblock, etc.). Snacks and water will be provided for NICC volunteers. Masks and social distancing will be required.

All trees are 1-gallon. Following is a list of what will be planted and how many: Live Oak (166), Shumard Oak (167), Longleaf Pine (167), American Elm (167), Pignut Hickory (166), and Sugarberry (167).

Attached is a map of Governors Park (which is just north of the Publix off Blair Stone Rd.). There is a “P” parking icon on the NW side of park. Please park there. There will be signs to help you navigate where to walk to from the parking location.
